2011 TORRONTÉS

The emblematic white wine of Argentina, the 2011 Recuerdo Torrontés is cultivated in the Argentine province of La Rioja. The quality of this region results in extremely aromatic varieties. The wine is fermented in stainless steel tanks to preserve its fruit intensity and lively aromatics. Bright, fresh, and full of summer, Torrontés has a clean straw color with aromatic points of lemon spritz, citrus, and tart white flowers. The mouth is filled with tropical fruit, fresh with mineral notes and clean essences. It is streamlined with fresh orange zest that rounds out with acidity and ripe pears that linger into a lush finish.

SOIL:

Sandy clay topsoil on top of clay and sandstone

VINIFICATION:

The grapes were sourced from 30-40 year old vines and were harvested at optimal maturity. Fermentation was slow, with selected yeasts, at low temperatures.
